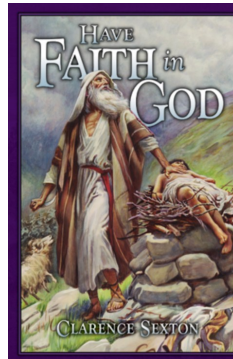

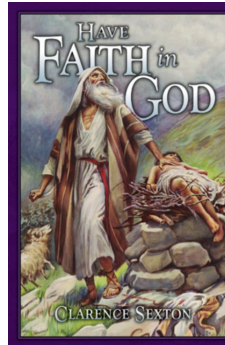

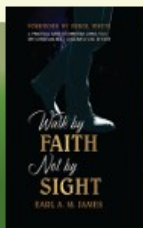


Despite his trials and opposition from those closest to him, Job never abandoned his faithfulness to God. He preserved his confidence and integrity before Him.
